7. Principals Report

- 370 students – Have exceeded projections of 355 with fluctuations on a day to day basis
- Extra curricular activities continue – cross country, book club, intramurals, best buddies, cooking club.
- Archery- Have 3 people trained to help bring the program back to the school
- Playground renovation was met with some challenges over the summer. Division and company are trying to resolve issues with expenses incurred and will continue until the issues are resolved.

- Community – Tisdale HUB- agencies helping to bring together families who are struggling in different ways.
- Nutrition grant proposal- School proposal to use towards cooking club along with involvement from the GOOD Food box
- Staffing changes- Lori Rosvold is TES's new complexity teacher, are trying to hire a full time permanent EA and will be conducting interviews next week.
- School Goals
 - Teachers are working on math instruction through math Up, Thinking classrooms and division PDs
 - Assessment practices – NESD assessment HUB
 - Learning Stories
 - Student ownership in learning – SLCs
 - Student well being and inclusion through calming corners, mental health awareness, groups are creating tools for self regulation
- Community engagement through different community groups/leaders such as dentist, optometrist, fire department, police
- School is working with a custodian shortage and have met with the superintendent and director to address concerns
- Roof leaks were patched in June but are still leaking
- Outdoor learning spaces- playground renovation. Grant money cannot be used for outdoor learning by maybe ground cover, etc.
- Mitchell's fundraising – spices and soups
- Other fundraising opportunities include family pizza, reusable bags, smencils, mabels labels
- Authentic family engagement
 - Backdrops purchased for open house
 - Draw baskets
 - Food and supplies
 - \$81 to the Stone Soup Grade 1 event
- Terry Fox fundraising – collecting through online donations
- Better together school apparel- Tisdale suicide/better together will donate new shirts for pre K, K, and new students. Will purchase new school design.
