

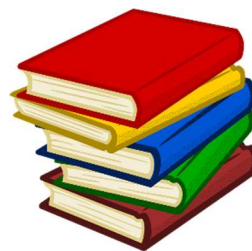
Grade 1 Supplies List 2026-2027

*Please bring all supplies on the first day of school or to the Backpack Drop Off.

*All supplies should be clearly labelled with your child's name.

*Please send only the items listed. Do not send handheld sharpeners, fancy pencils and erasers, etc.

- 2 Fine Tip Dry Erase Markers
- 1 Fine Tip Black Permanent Marker
- 1 Highlighter
- 1 Box of Washable Markers
- 1 Box of Wax Crayons
- 1 Box of Pencil Crayons
- 2 Plastic Pencil Boxes (*see photos*)
- 2 Hilroy Half Page Dotted Interlined Notebook (top half blank, bottom half dotted interlined – *see photo on the next page*)
- 8 Duotangs (1 each of red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, white and black. Paper works ok, but plastic duo tangs are more durable if you choose.)
- 15 HB Pencils (good quality & pre-sharpened – **please label pencils with marker not stickers**)
- 4 White Erasers
- 1 Pair of Scissors
- 3 Glue Sticks (purple works well)
- 1 Pair of Indoor Slip-On Velcro Running Shoes (**no laces and non-marking soles**)
- 1 Oversized Art/Painting Shirt
- 1 Water Bottle
- 1 Large Ziploc Bag (for extra supplies)
- 1 4x6 or 5x7 Family Photo



Organizing school supplies can be a daunting task. Please follow these special requests to make things as easy as possible for your child on their first day. Make sure all supplies are

labelled clearly with their name. This is super helpful when we find crayons and markers on the floor. Extra supplies should be put in a large Ziploc bag that we will store and use as needed.

Examples of how school supplies should be sent:
